Democratic Party Section	Republican Party Section	Fremont Library Millage Proposal Shall the Fremont Area District Library, County of Newaygo, Michigan, be authorized to levy a new additional millage annually in an amount not to exceed 1.25 mills (\$1.25 on each \$1,000 of taxable value) against all taxable property within the Fremont Area District Library district for a period of ten (10) years, 2020 to 2029, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for all district library purposes authorized by law? The estimate of the revenue the Fremont Area District Library will collect if the millage is approved and levied by the Fremont Area District Library in the first year (2020) is approximately \$567,000. By law, a portion of the revenue collected may be subject to capture by the City of Fremont Brownfield Redevelopment Authority.
