To participate, all you have to do is come in to the Fremont City office, give us your name, address and phone number, plus a fee of \$3.00, and you're on the list! **(Please note deadlines below)**. We will send the information (address only!) to the Hi-Lites and they will create an advertisement with the city map to go into the weekly paper, the Sunday before the sale.

Garage, Yard & Estate Sales

Do I need a permit from the City of Fremont in order to have a garage/yard or estate sale?

No. However, you do have to adhere to the regulations in the Fremont Zoning Ordinance under Section 6.22 and Section 6.15 A7.

How often may I hold a sale?

In residential districts, garage and yard sales shall be limited to no more than three (3) events per calendar year. No garage or yard sale event shall last more than three (3) consecutive days.



Are there limits on where I can place yard, garage or estate sale signs?

Yes. Garage, yard and estate sale signs are allowed, provided that there is only (1) sign per premise; that the sign is placed on-premise only, and that it is located entirely on private property.

How large can a garage, yard or estate sign be?

The sign cannot exceed six (6) square feet in area.

How long can the garage, yard or estate sale sign be up?

The sign is to be erected no more than five (5) business days before and is to be removed within one (1) business day after the announced sale.

If I have questions, who can I call?

Call the City's zoning administrator at 231-924-2101.

Note: No sign can be placed in the City's right-of-way or attached to a light pole. Signs will be confiscated by City staff and disposed of if located in these areas. Please help the community retain its appealing character by adhering to these rules.
