**Discussion on Town & Country Path Phase 2 Construction**

Brian Hettinger reported most of the construction of Phase 2 was complete. The paving was complete for the wooded area and along Locust Avenue in the Industrial Park. The DPW completed the north bridge over Maat Creek and the contractor, Meauwenberg Excavating, is approximately 50% done with the south bridge. He also reported the DPW had installed additional signs, benches and mini-picnic pavilions in both Phases 1 & 2.

**Recreation Authority Update**

Dave reported the Recreation Authority sub-committee has started meeting and are looking for additional members to participate.

**'The Refuge' (Sheridan Twp Bike Path Project)**

Dave also reported the new 'Refuge' path project is going well and the Fremont Rotary Club will be working on cleanup and preparation this Saturday. This will save project funds for future construction.

Rhondi noted the 'Safe Routes to Schools' sub-committee will meeting soon.
