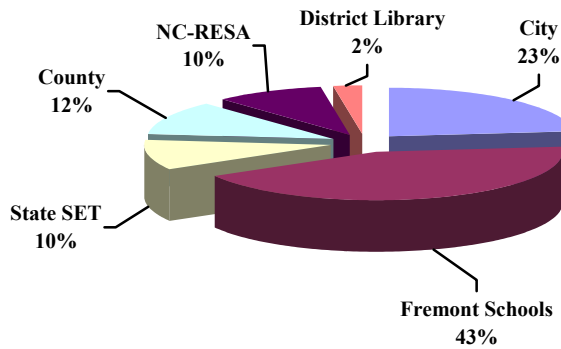

Fremont:

- City's total millage is 14 mills (Charter allows 20.) No additional mills are levied or special assessed for any City services, including Fire.
- Fremont Schools received approval for 1.75-mill sinking fund millage, which was first levied in 2002.

Newaygo:

- City's total millage of 19.8334 includes general operating and a citywide special assessment for fire protection services. The City is also considering the formation of a District Library, which may establish a Library levy.

Grant:

- City's millage of 16.4733 includes general operating, fire protection and a sanitary sewer debt.
- The new District Library levies 0.8477 for the new building and 0.9016 for general operating.

Hesperia:

- Village residents pay a total of 17.0814 mills. This includes the Village's millage of 14.3772 mills (for general operating and streets) plus the Denver Township levies for general operating (0.8678), roads (0.9440) and fire protection (0.8924 mills.)

SET: The State Education Tax (SET) was raised back up to one mill from 5 to 6 mills for 2004.
